MIXED UP? →



**Finally!** From youth care service into your own home – leaving care is a big step! It comes with the freedom to make decisions yourself. Nevertheless, obligations in everyday life increase with your own flat and you have full responsibility for what happens next. All this can be a bit overwhelming sometimes.

FLAT, JOB, EDUCATION, FRIENDS, NEIGHBOURS, MONEY...  
HOW DOES ALL THIS BALANCE OUT?

**The team of Home Support  
will assist you in case you need help to solve problems.**

**Flat** In case you can't pay the rent or the electricity bills and you are just about to lose your flat

**Money** In case you need to apply for unemployment benefit (Arbeitslosengeld 2) or other social benefits

**Job or education** In case you are looking for a school, a training or a job

**Public authorities** In case you need support enforcing your rights. We also accompany you to appointments with public authorities

**Every day problems** We support you in solving everyday problems (e.g. health issues) and can also help you finding the adequate assistance

**Who can turn to Home Support?** You can contact us in case you are between 18 and 27 years of age, are living in your own flat and ...

... prior to that stayed in youth care service and were housed via the Youth Office or the ASD in a supervised youth flat (§§30, 34, 35 SGB VIII), got assistance for young adults (§41 SGB VIII) or stayed in a district crisis or guest flat, lived in foster care or were released pursuant to §§ 35 SGB VIII from intensive socio-educational individual help

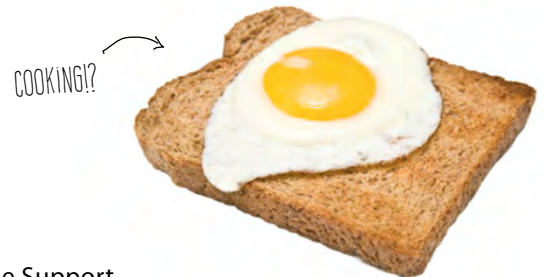
... prior to that you were supported by "Jugend Aktiv plus"

... you are a young mother / father and moved out of a supervised flat (§19 SGB VIII)

**Who is Home Support?** Our team consists of 4 social workers. Our support is free of charge and optional: you decide which issue you want to work on. And of course we treat your matters with confidentiality.

**How to reach us?** You can give us a call or contact us via mail or the contact form on our website. You can also just drop in during our opening times. It is as well possible to meet in your flat and jointly tackle what you want to tackle.

If you would like to come for a first meeting accompanied by your adviser, it is best to make an appointment with us.
